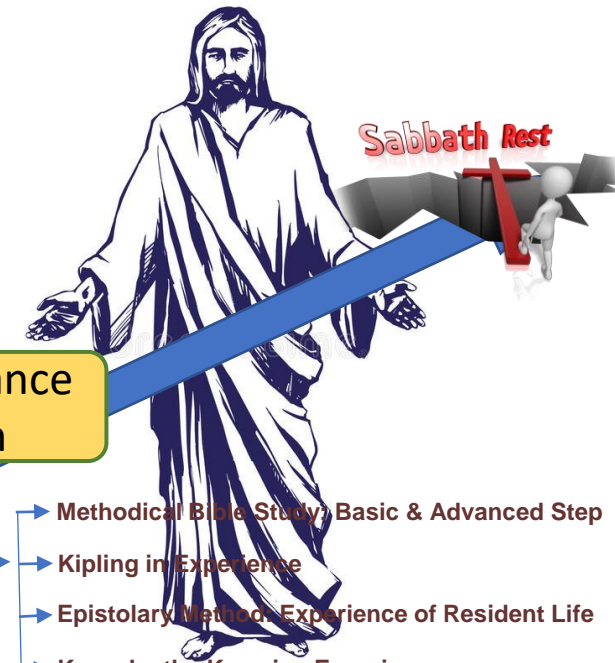

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## God's Home Among Humans 2 Samuel 7:11-16

This passage about God's establishment and protection of the Davidic kingdom was picked up for various purposes in the first-century world, perhaps most strikingly by the early Christians who applied it to Jesus. David's impulse that God should have a grand house was right, but God had bigger plans than David had imagined. By coming in the person of Jesus, God made clear that the grand house of his dwelling is creation itself. God makes human beings in such a way that it will be appropriate for him to come himself in the person of his son and be a human among humans. This is the hope revealed at Advent.

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## About Dr. Hill

Dr. Charles Hill joined RTS-Orlando in 1994 and served as John R. Richardson Professor of New Testament and Early Christianity until his retirement in May 2021. He taught core courses on Hebrews-Revelation and New Testament Greek, and is now Professor Emeritus of New Testament and Early Christianity. After receiving his Ph.D. from Cambridge University, Dr. Hill taught at Northwestern College in Iowa.

Dr. Hill has significant research interest in the Johannine Corpus, New Testament books associated with the Apostle John (Gospel of John, 1-3 John and Revelation). He also has researched and written extensively on several issues related to the early church fathers, particularly early Christian views of the end times, the canon of the New Testament and the New Testament manuscript tradition. Dr. Hill's most recent publications include *Who Chose the Gospels? Probing the Great Gospel Conspiracy* (Oxford University Press, 2010) and *The Early Text of the New Testament* (Oxford University Press, 2012), edited with RTS Professor Michael J. Kruger.

### “The Truth Above All Demonstration”: Scripture in the Patristic Period to Augustine

Nearly two millennia after their latest constituent member saw the light of day, the books that make up the Christian Bible continue to play an indispensable role in the spiritual lives of churches and individual believers. Yet today, many who wish to honor Scripture as the word of God can scarcely do so unaware that nearly every aspect of the study and use of their prized volume is under dispute. Whether the topic be the origins of Scripture's individual books, the early scribal transmission of those books, their eventual collection into an exclusive “canon,” their interpretation, their reliability or truthfulness, or the role they play in the church's attempt to define itself (and others), the reader of Scripture faces no lack of critical scrutiny. It is not surprising, then, that many should think of looking to the “pre-critical” past and should hark back specifically to the early centuries of the Christian era, when the foundations for scriptural exegesis in the Christian tradition were being laid and when Scripture was finding its place in the worshipping life of the church.

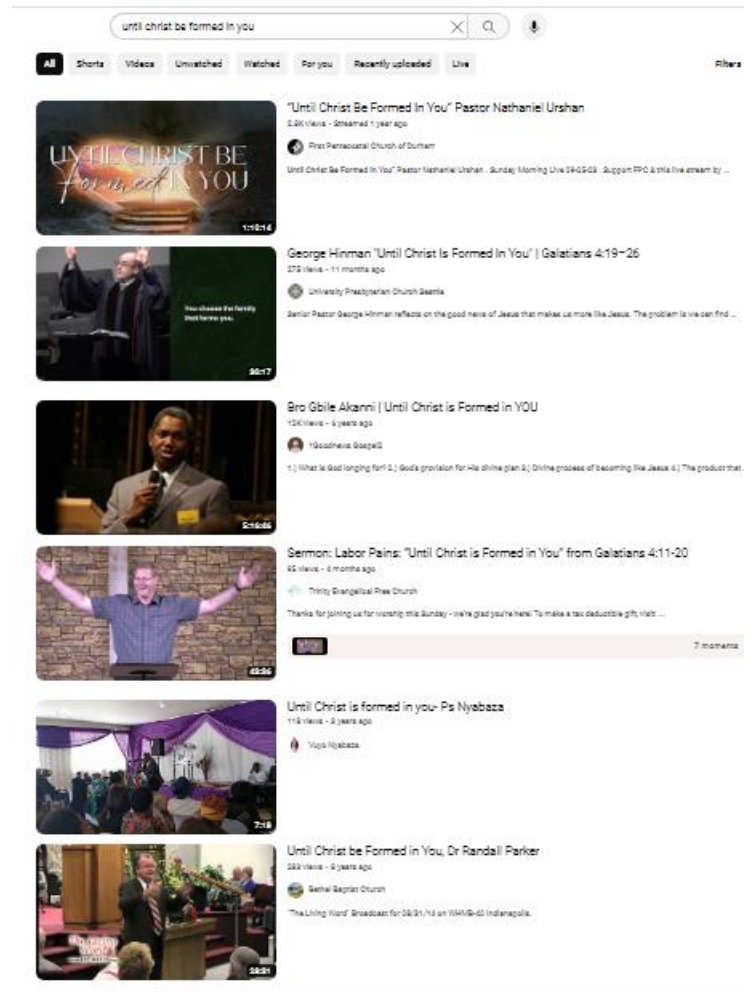

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# The Epistle to the HEBREWS

1 In many and various ways God spoke of old to our fathers by the prophets, 2 but in these last days he has spoken to us by a Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. 3 He reflects the glory of God and bears the very stamp of his nature, upholding the universe by his word of power. When he had made purification for himself, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, 4 having become much superior to angels as the name he has obtained is more excellent than theirs.

5 For to what angel did God ever say, "Thou art my Son, today I have begotten thee?" Or again, "I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son." 6 And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him." 7 Of the angels he says, "Who makes his angels winds, and his servants flames of fire." 8 But of the Son he says, "Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever, the righteous scepter is the scepter of the kingdom. 9 Thou hast loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; therefore God, thy God, has anointed thee with oil of gladness beyond thy comrades." 10 And, "Thou, Lord, didst found the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the work of thy hands." 11 They will perish, but thou remainest; they will all grow old like a garment, 12 like a mantle thou wilt roll them up, and they will be changed. But thou art the same, and thy years will never end." 13 But to what angel has he ever said, "Sit at my right hand, till I make thy enemies a stool for thy feet?" 14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to serve, for the sake of those who are to obtain salvation?

21 Therefore we must pay the closest attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away from it. 2 For when angels declared by angels was valid and every transgression or disobedience received a just retribution, 3 how shall we escape if we neglect such a great salvation? It was declared at first by the Lord, and it is attested to us by those who hear him, 4 and while God also bore witness by signs and wonders and various miracles and by gifts bestowed in us according to his own will.

5 For it was not to angels that God subjected the world to come, of which we are speaking. 6 It has been testified so many times, "What is man that thou carest for him?" 7 Thou didst make him for a little while lower than the angels, thou hast crowned him with glory and honor, 8 and hast put everything in subjection under his feet.

14 Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same nature, that through death he might destroy him who has the power of death, that is, the devil, 15 and deliver all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong bondage. 16 For surely it is not with angels that he is concerned but with the descendants of Abraham.

27 Therefore, brethren, we have been made like them in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make expiation for the sins of the people. 18 For because he himself has suffered as we are, yet without sin, 16 Let us then, with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

5:1 For every high priest chosen from among men is appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and sacrifice for sin. 3 The carnal body he has like us, and like us he is subject to weakness; hence it is necessary for him to be made like us in every respect that he may be a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make expiation for the sins of the people. 4 And one does not take the honor upon himself, but he is called by God, just as Aaron was.

5:5 So also Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him, "Thou art my Son, today I have begotten thee," 6 as he says elsewhere, "Thou art a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."

7:1 In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, and was heard for his godly fear. 8 Although he was a Son, he learned obedience through what he suffered: 9 and being made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey him, 10 being designated by God a high priest after the order of Melchizedek.

11:1 About this we have much to say which is hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing. 12 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the basic principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to need milk, not solid food. 13 For every one who lives on milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, he is a child. 14 But solid food is for those who have their faculties trained by practice to distinguish good from evil.

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6:1 Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 with instruction about abstractions, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment. 3 And this is impossible to restore again to repentance those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit, 5 and have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the age to come, 6 if they then consent to apostasy, since they crucify the Son of God on their own account and hold him up to contempt. 7 For land which has drunk the rain that has fallen on it and which has borne a fruitful crop, and which has received the blessing of God, is able to produce much more grain.

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**1 John RSV**

**1** That which was from the beginning, which we have seen and heard, which we have looked upon and touched, and which we have seen and heard, we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us; and our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. 2 And we are writing this that our joy may be complete.

**3** This is the message which we have heard from him and proclaimed to you, that God is light and in him is no darkness at all. 4 If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not love according to the truth, but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. 5 If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 6 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just, and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 7 If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

**8** My little children, I am writing this to you so that you may not sin; but if any one does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous; 9 and he is the expiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

**10** And by this we may be sure that we know him, if we keep his commandments. 11 He who says, "I know him" but does not keep his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him; 12 but whoever keeps his word, in him truly love for God is perfected. By this we may be sure that we are in him: 13 he who says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked.

**14** Beloved, I am writing you about those who do not receive the word which you heard from the beginning; the old commandment is the word which you have heard. 15 Yet I am writing you a new commandment, which is true in him and true, and is no lie, just as his nature is passing away and the true light is already shining. 16 He who says he is in the light and hates his brother is in the darkness still. 17 He who loves his brother abides in the light, and in it there is no cause for stumbling. 18 But he who hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

**19** See what love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God, and so we are. But reason why the Father loves us is that we know him; 20 we do not know him who denies the Son who is revealed by the Father. 21 Every one who denies the Son who has heard and seen him shall see his judgment, and every one who receives him receives the Father who has sent him. 22 Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus has come in the flesh? This is the antichrist, who denies the Father and the Son. 23 No one who denies the Son has the Father; he who confesses the Son has the Father also. 24 Let what you heard from the beginning abide in you. If you do not receive what you heard from the beginning, you will not abide in the Son and in the Father who came to the world in this way in which he walked.

**25** And this is what he has promised us, eternal life, and God abides in him.

**27** Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to whether they are of God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world. 28 By this you know the Spirit of God: if any one confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh, he is of God; 29 and every one who confesses that Jesus Christ has not come in the flesh is a deceiver and the anti-Christ, of whom you heard that he was coming, and now he is in the world already.

**30** Therefore if you should hear that any one does not bear witness to Jesus Christ who came by water and blood, not with the water only but with the blood, do not receive him into your house, and do not greet him. 31 Who is the one who bears witness to the testimony of the Spirit, the water, and the blood, and these three agree. 32 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just, and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 33 If we do not confess our sins, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

**34** If you hear of a brother who has committed a mortal sin, do not think that you will be able to pray for him. 35 For all that is mortal sin, I do not say that one is to pray for that. 36 All wrongdoing is sin, but there is sin which is not mortal.

**37** We know that any one born of God does not sin, but He who was born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him.

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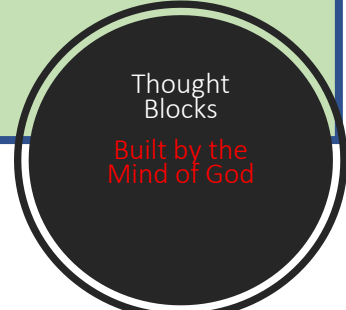
**39** We know that we are of God, and the whole world is in the power of the evil one.
