Heb 1:1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners ~~spake~~ in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

2 Hath in these last days **spoken unto us by his Son**, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

4 Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.

Was Jesus always well pleasing to the Father?

What did HE have as a human being?

Is it possible to have what HE had/has?

How, when, by what presented means?

**Heb 10:19** Therefore, brethren,  
since we have confidence  
to enter the sanctuary  
by the blood of Jesus,

**20** by  
the new and living way  
which he opened for us  
through the curtain, that is,  
through his flesh,

**21** and  
since we have a great priest  
over the house of God,

**22** let us  
draw near  
with a true heart  
in full assurance of faith,  
with our hearts sprinkled clean  
from an evil conscience and  
our bodies washed  
with pure water.

Eph 4:17 Now this I affirm and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds;

18 they are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart;

19 they have become callous and have given themselves up to licentiousness, greedy to practice every kind of uncleanness.

20 You did not so learn Christ!--

21 assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus.

22 Put off your old nature which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful lusts,

23 and be renewed in the spirit of your minds,

24 and put on the new nature, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.
