# Indwelling of the Holy Spirit

## Spirit

### 1 Seal of Inheritance

Ephesians: Spirit guarantees believers' eternal inheritance.

### 2 Inner Strength

Ephesians: Spirit strengthens inner being, Christ dwells within.

### 3 Christ In You

Colossians: Indwelling Christ as hope of glory.

### 4 Spirit of Sonship

Galatians: God's Spirit in believers' hearts.



# Jesus as Son of God and Savior

1

Ephesians

Redemption through Christ's blood, Savior of the church.

2

Colossians

Deliverance through Son, fullness of deity in Christ.

3

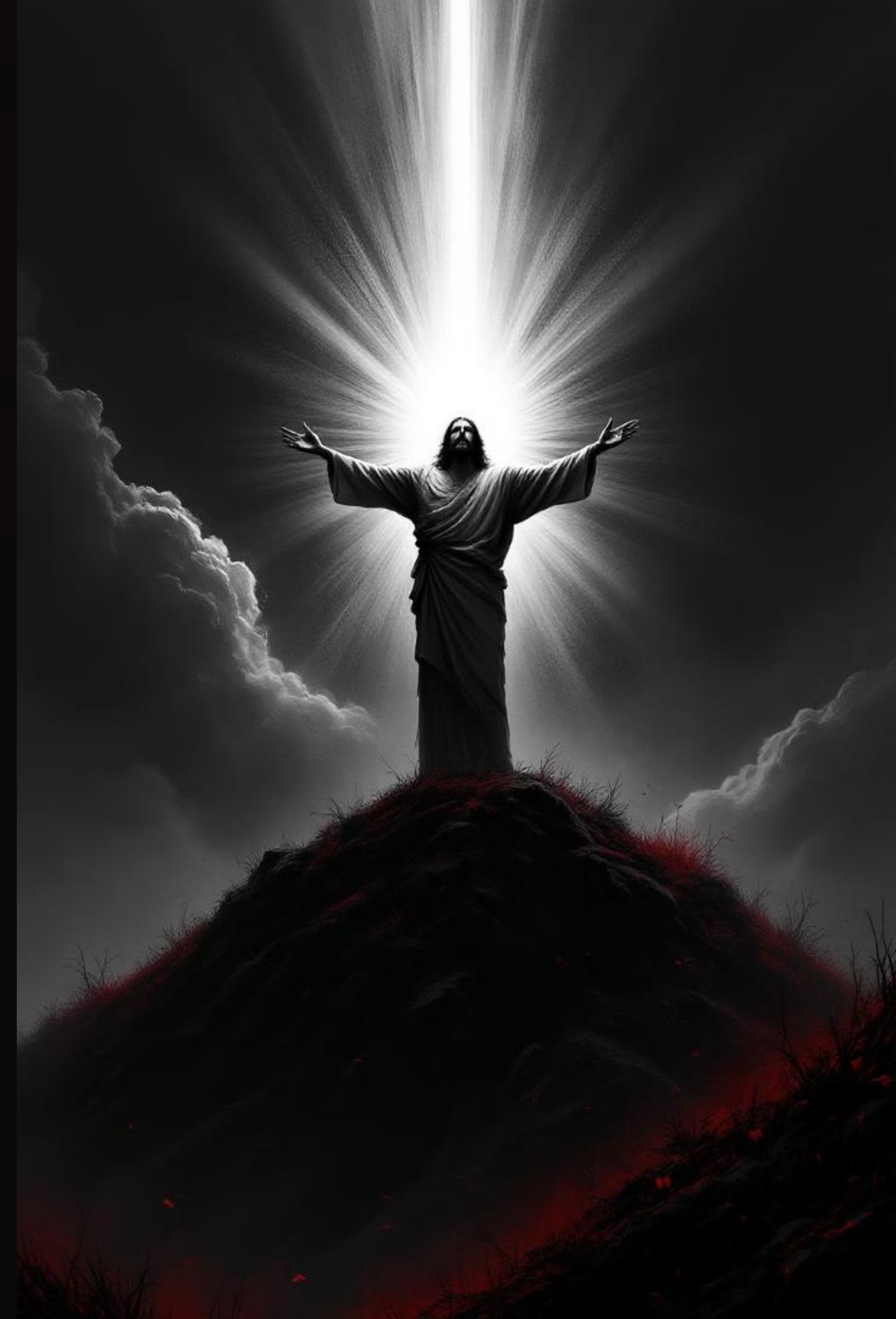
Galatians

Christ gave Himself for sins, loved and died.

4

Hebrews

Jesus: Creator, Purifier, source of eternal salvation.



# Confession of Faith

## Ephesians

Salvation by grace through faith,  
not works.

## Colossians

Continue living in Christ as  
received Him.

## Galatians

Children of God through faith in  
Christ Jesus.





# God's Love and Abiding in Him Him

## Ephesians

Rooted in love, imitators of God's love.

## Colossians

Love as bond of perfectness.

## Galatians

Faith working through love, fruit of Spirit.

## Hebrews

God's love shown through discipline of His children.



# Christological Focus



## Lordship

Christ as supreme authority in believers' lives.



## Sacrifice

Emphasis on Christ's atoning death for sins.



## Mediator

Jesus as bridge between God and humanity.





# Soteriological Implications

## Justification

Righteousness imputed through faith in Christ.

2

## Sanctification

Ongoing process of growth in Christlikeness.

3

## Glorification

Ultimate conformity to Christ's image in eternity.
