#### 1 John's Method of Study

The First Epistle of John is the written format of the Holy Spirit's teaching method for bringing every believer to the full mature faith of experientially knowing they actually have the LIFE of God indwelling them and jointly participate in this LIFE as HE Lives. ONE LIFE Lived.

Not GET LIFE but HAVE LIFE to LIVE LIFE

Paragraph by paragraph, verse by verse John embraces the believer. John draws upon the actual experience of the LIFE of God in each believer bringing them to an every deeper and fuller revelatory understanding of the LIFE they have and the ONE PERSON indwelling them as their own. The consequent result is the fully assured personal knowledge of each to the reality that they have ETERNAL LIFE and are at full REST in HIM.




## Working Papers






