Jesus Made a Surety

- **surety** – *enguos* – “bail” (only place in Bible)
- Jesus is **more than a mediator** who “negotiates” between God and man on man’s behalf
- He provides **his personal guarantee** of life and property – he is answerable for the fulfillment of the obligation which he guarantees
- The old covenant had **mediators** (angels – Gal. 3:19), but no **surety**
- As the Son of God, Jesus confirms God’s eternal covenant with man. As Man’s representative, he satisfies in terms with perfect acceptance in God’s sight

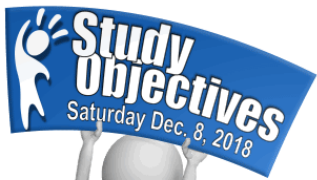

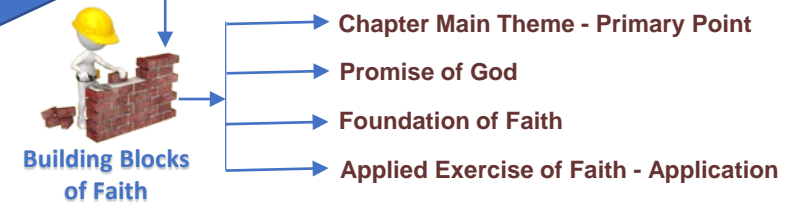

SURETY

- A surety is a substitute, sponsor, or bondsman, who legally and voluntarily assumes the obligation of another person.

Pulpit Commentary
 Verse 7. - And he took the Book of the Covenant. In this book we have the germ of the Holy Scriptures - the first "book" actually mentioned as written in the narrative of the Bible. Genesis may contain other older documents, inserted by Moses, under the sanction of the Holy Spirit, in his compilation. But his own composition, if we except the burst of poesy called forth by the passage of the Red Sea ([Exodus 15:1-18](#)), would seem to have commenced with "the Book of the Covenant." Upon this nucleus the rest of the law was based; and it was to explain and enforce the law that Moses composed the Pentateuch. In the audience of the people, Literally, "in the ears of the people," which is equally intelligible, and more graphic. And they said, etc The people made the same answer as before (ver. 3), adding a general promise of obedience to all that God might command in future.

Definition of Obedience in the Bible

The general concept of obedience both in the [Old and New Testament](#) relates to [hearing](#) or hearkening to a higher authority. One of the Greek terms for obedience conveys the idea of positioning oneself under someone by submitting to their authority and command. Another Greek word for obey in the New Testament means "to trust."

According to *Holman's Illustrated Bible Dictionary* a succinct definition of biblical obedience is "to hear God's Word and act accordingly." *Eerdman's Bible Dictionary* states, "True 'hearing,' or obedience, involves the physical hearing that inspires the hearer, and a belief or trust that in turn motivates the hearer to act in accordance with the speaker's desires."

Thus, biblical obedience to God means to hear, trust, submit and [surrender to God](#) and his Word.
