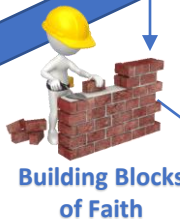

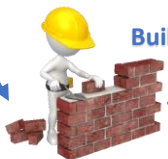

1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon and touched with our hands, concerning the word of life—**2** the life was made manifest, and we saw it, and testify to it, and proclaim to you the eternal life which was with the Father and was made manifest to us—**3** that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us; and our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. **4** And we are writing this that our joy may be complete.

4 Every one who commits sin is guilty of lawlessness; sin is lawlessness. **5** You know that he appeared to take away sins, and in him there is no sin. **6** No one who abides in him sins; no one who sins has either seen him or known him. **7** Little children, let no one deceive you. He who does right is righteous, as he is righteous. **8** He who commits sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil. **9** No one born of God commits sin; for God's nature abides in him, and he cannot sin because he is born of God. **10** By this it may be seen who are the children of God, and who are the children of the devil: whoever does not do right is not of God, nor he who does not love his brother.

1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, which we have touched with our hands, concerning the life which was made manifest, and we have seen, and testify to it, and proclaim to you, eternal life, which was with the Father and made manifest to us—that which we have heard and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us; and our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. **2** And we are writing this that our joy may be complete.

3 This is the message which we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light and in him is no darkness at all. **4** If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not live according to the truth, but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. **5** If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. **6** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just, and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. **7** If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

8 My little children, I am writing this to you so that you may not sin; but if any one does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. **9** And he is the expiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

10 And by this we may be sure that we know him, if we keep his commandments. **11** He who says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him; **12** but whoever keeps his word, in him truly love for God is perfected. By this we may be sure that we are in him: **13** he who says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked.

14 Beloved, I am writing you no new commandment, but an old commandment which you had from the beginning: the old commandment is the word which you have heard. **15** Yet I am writing you a new commandment, which is true in him and true, and in you, because the darkness is passing away and the true light is already shining. **16** He who says he is in the light but hates his brother is in the darkness still. **17** He who loves his brother abides in the light, and in it there is no cause for stumbling. **18** But he who hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

1 I am writing to you, little children, because your sins are forgiven for his sake. **2** I am writing to you, because you know him who is false, and you know him who is true, and you have overcome him who is false. **3** Do not let anyone deceive you in this: the one who denies that Jesus Christ came in the flesh is the deceiver and his punishment is severe. **4** Every one who commits sin is guilty of lawlessness, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the evil one.

5 Do not love the world or the things of the world. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the pride of life, is not of the Father who is in the world. **6** And the world passes and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.

7 Children, it is the last hour, and as you hear that antichrist is coming, so now antichrists have come; therefore we know it is the last hour. **8** They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us; but went out, that it might be plain that they are not of us.

9 But you have been anointed by the One, and you all know. **10** I write to you because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and know that no lie is of the truth. **11** Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, who denies the Father and the Son. **12** No one who denies the Son has the Father. He who confesses the Son has the Father also. **13** Let what you heard from the beginning abide in you. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, then you will abide in the Son and in the Father who sent him. **14** And this is what he has promised us, eternal life, and God abides in him.

15 By this we shall know that we are of the truth, and reassure our hearts before him. **16** Whenever our hearts condemn us, for God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything. **17** Beloved, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence before God. **18** And we receive from him whatever we ask, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him. **19** And this is his commandment, that we should believe in the name of the Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us. **20** All who keep his commandments abide in him, and he in them. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he gives us.

21 In this is love perfected with us, that we may have confidence for the day of judgment, because as he is so are we in this world. **22** There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and he who fears is not perfected in love. **23** We love, because he first loved us. **24** If any one says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. **25** And this commandment we have from him, that he who loves God should love his brother also.

17 As to you who believe in the name of God, that you may know that you are true, and that you are confident in him, that if we ask anything we hear us in whatever we ask, we have obtained the requests made any one sees his brother committing a mortal sin, he will ask, and his life for those whose sin is not mortal, I do not say that one is to pray for that. **18** All wrongdoing is sin, but there is sin which is not mortal.

19 We know that any one born of God does not sin, but He who was born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him.

20 We know that we are of God, and the whole world is in the power of the evil one.

21 And given us understanding, to know him who is true, and he is in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Christ, this is the true God and eternal life. **22** Little children, keep yourselves from idols.
