And his commandments are not burdensome. 1:28 Whoever is born of God overcomes the world, and this is the victory that overcomes the world, our faith. 1:29 Who is it that overcomes the world but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God? 1:30 He who does not believe in Jesus who came by water and blood, not with the water only but with the blood. 1:31 And the Spirit is because the Spirit is the truth. 1:32 We witness, the Spirit, the water, and these three agree. 1:33 If we testify of men, the testimony of the Spirit for this is the testimony of God true witness to his Son. 1:34 He who is the Son of God has the testimony that he does not believe God has lied, because he has not believed in that God has borne to his Son. 1:35 The testimony that God gave us eternal life is in his Son. 1:36 He who has life, he who has not the Son of God, is a liar. 1:37 He who testifies that Jesus is the Son of God, God, that you may know that you love him, and that you may have confidence in him, that if we ask anything his will he hears us. 1:38 And if we ask anything in whatever we ask, we have obtained the requests made any one sees his brother committing a mortal sin, he will ask, and his life for those whose sin is not mortal, I do not say that one is to pray for that. 1:39 All wrongdoing is sin, but there is sin which is not mortal. 1:40 We know that any one born of God does not sin, but He who was born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him. 1:41 We know that we are of God, and the whole world is in the power of the evil one. 1:42 And given that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, to know him who is true, and to be in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Christ, this is the true God and eternal life. 1:43 Little children, keep yourselves from idols.
