1:1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are also faithful in Christ Jesus: **2** Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

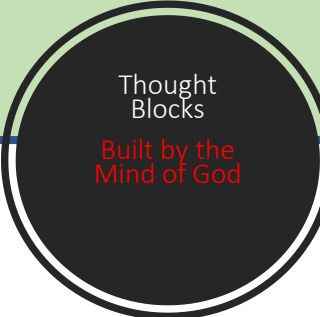

By this we may be sure that we are in him: 13/ he who says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked. 14/ Beloved, I am writing you no new commandment, but an old commandment which you have had from the beginning; the old commandment is the word which you have heard. 15/ Yet I am writing you a new commandment, which is true in him and in us, because the darkness is passing away and the true light is already shining. 16/ He who says he is in the light and hates his brother is in the darkness still. 17/ He who loves his brother abides in the light, and in it there is no cause for stumbling. 18/ But he who hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes. 19/ I am writing to you, little children, because your sins are forgiven for his sake. 20/ I am writing to you, because you know the Son who is to come, and do not let anyone deceive you with a greeting. 21/ Who denies that Jesus Christ came in the flesh, that person the Father does not receive, and whoever receives such a person, his share in his works will be. 22/ Who has a son who does these things, the Father will receive him, and he will make his share in his works. 23/ See what love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are. The love that we have for one another is that we should love one another, just as we have loved the Father who has sent his Son to be the atonement for our sins. 24/ Who does not love his brother whom he has seen, that person who does not love his brother whom he has not seen, how can he love God, of whom he has never heard? This is the love which is of God, that we love one another, just as we have loved the Father. 25/ Every one who commits sin is guilty of lawlessness, and the word of God abides in him, and he has overcome the evil one. 26/ Do not love the world or the things of the world; for all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the pride of life, is not of the Father who is in the world. 27/ And the world passes and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever. 28/ Children, it is the last hour, and as you hear that antichrist is coming, so now antichrists have come; therefore you know their work. 29/ They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us; but they went out, that it might be plain that they were not of us. 30/ But you have been anointed by the One, and you all know. 31/ I write to you, because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and know that no lie is of the truth. 32/ Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, he who denies the Father and the Son. 33/ No one who denies the Son has the Father; he who confesses the Son has the Father also. 34/ Let what you heard from the beginning abide in you; if you do not do this, you will not see the Son of God, and you will not have his life. 35/ The one who receives a false witness shares in his works. 36/ By this we shall know that we are of the truth, and reassure our hearts before him 37/ whenever our hearts condemn us; for God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything. 38/ Beloved, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence before God; 39/ and we receive from him whatever we ask, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him. 40/ And this is his commandment, that we should believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us. 41/ All who keep his commandments abide in him, and he in them, and they will receive the Father and the Son, and he who does not keep his commandments does not have the Father and the Son who have come into the world, and he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, that person who does not love his brother whom he has not seen, how can he love God, of whom he has never heard? This is the love which is of God, that we love one another, just as we have loved the Father. 42/ And this is the confidence we have in approaching God, that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. 43/ And if we do not receive what we ask, it is because we do not love the man who has loved us first. 44/ We love, because he first loved us. 45/ If any one says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. 46/ And this commandment we have from the Father, that the love which we have for one another is that we love one another, just as we have loved the Father who has sent his Son to be the atonement for our sins. 47/ In this is love perfected with us, that we may have confidence for the day of judgment, because as he is so are we in this world. 48/ There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and he who fears is not perfected in love. 49/ We love, because he first loved us. 50/ If any one says, "I love God," and does not love his brother who is with him, his love is false. 51/ We love, because he first loved us. 52/ If any one has seen that one is not praying for that. 53/ All wrongdoing is sin, but there is sin which is not mortal. 54/ We know that any one born of God does not sin, but He who was born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him. 55/ We know that we are of God, and the whole world is in the power of the evil one. 56/ And given us understanding, to know him who is true; and we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Christ, who is the true God and eternal life. 57/ Little children, keep yourselves from idols.

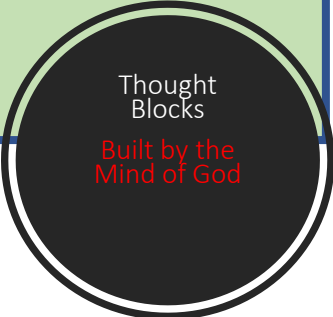

1/1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, touched with our hands, concerning the life which was made manifest, and we testify to it, and proclaim to you eternal life which was with the Father and made manifest to us—that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us; and our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. 2/ And we are writing this that our joy may be complete. 3/ This is the message which we have heard from him and proclaimed to you, that God is light and in him is no darkness at all. 4/ If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not live according to the truth, but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. 5/ If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 6/ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just, and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 7/ If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. 8/ My little children, I am writing this to you so that you may not sin; but if any one does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. 9/ And he is the expiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world. 10/ And by this we may be sure that we know him, if we keep his commandments. 11/ He who says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him; 12/ but whoever keeps his word, in him truly love for God is perfected.
