Thought Blocks

1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon and touched with our hands, concerning the word of life—2 the life was made manifest, and we saw it, and testify to it, and proclaim to you the eternal life which was with the Father and was made manifest to us—3 that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us; and our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. 4 And we are writing this that our joy may be complete.

5 This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light and in him is no darkness at all. 6 If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we do not live according to the truth; 7 but who is the light, as he is in the light, we fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus which cleanses us from all sin. 8 If we say we love him, but do not love his commandments, we deceive ourselves, and the blood of Jesus does not cleanse us from our sins. 9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 10 If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and we do not have his love in us.

11 Writing this to you so that you may not be deceived by anyone who does sin, we have written you the Father, Jesus Christ who is the expiation for our sins, and not only for our sins but also for the sins of the whole world. 12 Therefore, if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. 13 If anyone confesses his sins, he shall have mercy and forgiveness of sins. 14 We know that anyone who says, "I have not sinned," is a liar and his conscience does not bear witness to him. 15 But if we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 16 If anyone says, "I have not sinned," he deceives himself, and his sin will be his death. 17 If anyone loves his brother who has sinned, he will have his sin forgiven. 18 If anyone sees his brother who does not keep the commandments which we received, he should not greet him and wish him peace. 19 Whoever greets him who does not keep the commandments which we received, he shares in his works.

20 Therefore, if anyone has taken away these things, do not receive him into your house and do not greet him. 21 Whoever greets him who receives him shares in all his evil deeds. 22 Do not be deceived; anyone who does not keep the teaching of Christ which we received, do not receive him into your house and do not greet him. 23 If anyone greets him, he shares in his works. 24 Therefore, if anyone has heard these things, let him thank God. 25 And if anyone has not heard these things, do not receive him into your house and do not greet him. 26 If anyone teaches otherwise, do not receive him into your house and do not greet him. 27 If anyone greets him, he shares in his works.
